



## **UH COMD Graduate Specialty Tracks**

Students in the graduate program have the option to complete one of three Specialty Tracks. These tracks facilitate additional, focused knowledge and skills on (1) Multilingual/Multicultural Speech and Language Issues, (2) Medical Speech-Language Pathology, or (3) Public School Practice.

Specialty Tracks do not take the place of the core graduate curriculum, but rather they fulfill the 6-credit elective requirement. Students take 6 credits of elective courses in one specialty area. One of the externship placements will provide related clinical experience. Students who do a thesis can tailor their research project to one of the specialty areas to partially satisfy the requirements of a specialty track. Students wishing to select a specialty track must declare that decision by the end of the first spring semester. Students who opt not to complete a specialty track can take electives in a variety of topic areas.
